



Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's (PennDOT) Rapid Bridge Replacement Projects in our area include:

Route 234 (Narrows Road) over Conewago Creek in Franklin and Menallen Townships, Adams County, opened on August 10th.

Route 34 (Carlisle Road) bridge, spanning Hunters Run in South Middleton Township, Cumberland County, was reduced to one lane on June 4. Traffic will be controlled by a traffic light during construction which should be completed by the end of the year.

Route 34 (Carlisle Road) bridge, spanning Opossum Creek in Menallen Township, Adams County, closed to all traffic on June 11. Traffic is now detoured along Bendersville Road (Route 4006) and Center Mills Road (Route 4003). The bridge will reopen to traffic before the Aspers North replacement begins.

Quaker Valley Rd (1500 block) closed on August 6 for bridge replacement. The road is closed between P&Q Rd and Brysonia Rd until approx. Sept 10.

Aspers North Road (State Route 4006) over Opossum Creek in Menallen Township, Adams County, is scheduled to begin during the week of August 27.
